



### What your donation can do for Sidmouth Lifeboat

A donation of £10 can provide:

- Enough fuel to run the lifeboat engines for 15 minutes.
- A personal lifejacket flare for a crewmember's life jacket.
- A set of bandages for the lifeboat first aid kit.
- A heat reflective "Space Blanket" for a casualty.
- Gas bottles for 3 crewmember's lifejackets.
- Keeps 1 Lifeboat pager active for a year.

A donation of £100 can provide:

- Enough maroons for 4 lifeboat launches.
- Sea survival or radar training for 1 crewmember.
- 4 sets of gloves for the crew.
- 1 thermal under suit for dry suit.
- 1 repair to dry suit cuff & neck seals.

Every penny raised for the lifeboat is spent on keeping the boat and crew equipped and ready to respond 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. We are all volunteers and do not get paid anything. We receive no Government funding and can only operate because of the generosity of the public. Your donation, however small, makes a difference to the crew of the Sidmouth Lifeboat and the people we assist.
